**General Information:**

The Super Saturday Program serves as a complement to the Math Corps summer camp and keeps our family connected during the school year. The program, which runs 8 consecutive Saturdays from **January 20<sup>th</sup> – March 10<sup>th</sup>**, brings middle and high school students together with college students and mathematicians, to share in the teaching and learning of mathematics, in a university setting.

In addition to participating in grade-level and advanced studies in Mathematics, 9<sup>th</sup> grade students receive preliminary training designed to prepare them to fill the role of high school Teaching Assistant (TA) for the Math Corps Summer Programs.

The Super Saturday Program is free of charge for all students. TAs participate as volunteers and receive a problem-solving workshop that prepares them to maximize their performance on the Mathematics portion of the ACT college placement exam.

While priority is given to former summer camp participants, we welcome new members of the family.

# THE MATH CORPS CLEVELAND

## POLICIES AND EXPECTATIONS

The Math Corps Cleveland stands on the belief that all children have a unique and special greatness within them, and that through hard work and the support of a caring family or community – that greatness can be realized.

In keeping with the Math Corps' determination to help each and every one of its students find his or her own greatness, we ask that the following policies and expectations be observed:

1. **All students are expected to attend the program every day, in accordance with the program schedule.** An absence caused by illness, family emergency, or other unforeseen and unavoidable event may be excused, if prompt notification of the circumstances is given to the Program Coordinator. The Program Coordinator has sole authority for deciding whether any absence should be excused or not. Family vacations, reunions, and other similar outings conflict with the program's goals, and so will not be seen as reasons to excuse an absence. **Any unexcused absence is grounds for dismissal.**
2. **All students must be on time every day.** An incident of lateness caused by an unforeseen and unavoidable event may be excused, if prompt notification of the circumstances is given to the Program Coordinator. The Program Coordinator has sole authority for deciding whether any lateness should be excused or not. **Any unexcused lateness is grounds for dismissal.**
3. **All homework assignments are expected to be completed and turned in on time. Failure to complete assignments as required is grounds for dismissal.**
4. **All participants are to treat each other with respect and courtesy and are to maintain proper behavior at all times, consistent with being part of a university program. Behavior that fails to meet the standards of the Math Corps is grounds for dismissal.**
